MOTION TO APPEAR AND PARTICIPATE AT HEARING TELEPHONICALLY

The hearing in the above-captioned matter (the "Hearing") is set by the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the "Commission") for February 18, 2025, at 10:00 A.M. (CST), in Hearing Room G.201 located on the Ground Floor of the Andrew Jackson State Office Building, 500 Deaderick Street, Nashville, Tennessee.

Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-5-312(c) Limestone Water Utility Operating Company, LLC ("Limestone") submits this Motion to Appear and Participate at Hearing Telephonically (the "Motion") and provides the following in support of this Motion:

Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-5-312(c) addresses electronic participation at a hearing as follows:

In the discretion of the administrative judge or hearing officer and agency members and by agreement of the parties, all or part of the hearing may be conducted by telephone, television or other electronic means, if each participant in the hearing has an opportunity to participate in, to hear, and, if technically feasible, to see the entire proceedings while taking place.

Mr. D'Ascendis is located in Philadelphia which has been experiencing high winds.

Mr. D'Ascendis was scheduled to arrive in Nashville on Monday, but after repeated flight

cancellations is now scheduled to arrive in Nashville late Tuesday afternoon. For these reasons, and in accordance with the above-referenced statute, Limestone hereby respectfully requests that its witness, Dylan D'Ascendis, be allowed to participate in the Hearing telephonically or virtually.

If this Motion is granted, Limestone agrees that its electronic appearance and participation in the Hearing will be subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Petitioner's Tennessee attorney shall appear personally at the Hearing to present and facilitate questioning of Petitioner's witness.
- 2. Petitioner is solely responsible for, and shall be required to, secure a properly licensed Notary Public in good standing in the State of the jurisdiction where the testimony is to be given, and who will be in the same physical location with the witness while he is providing the testimony or ratifying pre-filed testimony.
- 3. The Notary Public obtained by Petitioner shall be duly authorized to administer the testimonial oath and shall do so during the Hearing and remain physically present with the witness at all times during the witness' testimony until such witness is excused from examination by the Commission or Hearing Officer.
- 4. Following conclusion of the Hearing, the Notary Public shall prepare and sign an affidavit, which bears the official seal of the Notary Public, affirming: (1) the proven identity of the witness, (2) the fact that the Notary Public properly administered the testimonial oath to such person, and (3) that testimony given by the sworn witness was in accordance with the highest ethical and legal standards, as observed by the Notary Public. In addition, the testifying witness shall sign a conforming Witness Certification in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A¹ or in such format ordered by the Commission or Hearing Officer.

¹To the extent the Commission has any issue with the form of Witness Certification or Affidavit attached hereto, Petitioner's counsel can revise accordingly upon notification and identification of the issue by the Commission.

5. The original Witness Certification and Notary Public Affidavit must be post-marked within five (5) days of the Hearing and received by the Hearing Officer via postage-paid U.S. Mail or overnight courier. Should the required affirming documents not be received by the Hearing Officer as required above, the testimony of the witness may be stricken from the record and constitute sufficient cause for denial of the Petition.

Wherefore, based on the foregoing, Limestone Water Utility Operating Company, LLC respectfully requests that the Commission enter an Order granting its Motion to Appear and Participate at Hearing Telephonically.
