Third Staff Data Request to Limestone Water Utility Operating Company
Docket No. 24-00044

1. Refer to pages 318-322 of Vol. II of the hearing transcript from February 19, 2025, in this matter. In the transcript, Mr. Thomas used the term “sanitary sewage overflow” (“SSO”) and indicated a reporting requirement for SSOs. Provide any reports made to the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation or any other local or state government agency for SSOs that may have occurred at the Grasslands system from December 26, 2024, through February 19, 2025.
2. Provide the date of any overflows in the common areas (i.e., soccer field) at the Grasslands system from December 26, 2024, through February 19, 2025.
3. Describe the specific cleanup steps and measures, including the date(s) of cleanup actions taken in response to any overflows reported in the common areas (i.e., soccer field) at the Grasslands system from December 26, 2024, through February 19, 2025.
4. In the event of any outstanding or unresolved reports of overflows at the Grasslands system, provide the current status of such reports and actions taken to address them, any actions still to be taken, and when such actions will be completed.
