NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

IN RE: PETITION OF LIMESTONE WATER UTILITY OPERATING COMPANY, LLC TO INCREASE CHARGES, FEES AND RATES AND FOR APPROVAL OF A GENERAL RATE INCREASE AND CONSOLIDATED RATES [PHASE 2 RATE IMPLEMENTATION]

The Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “TPUC”) invites the public to comment on the above-captioned matter regarding Limestone Water Utility Operating Company, LLC’s (“Limestone” or the “Company”) Phase 2 rate increase, which was approved by the Commission, as set forth in its *Order Setting Utility Rates* issued on July 10, 2025, as well as any other issues of concern. In its *Order*, the Commission determined that Limestone’s overall revenue deficiency was \$1,362,364 and ordered it to be recovered in two phases. The first phase began on May 1, 2025, and the second phase is scheduled to begin on May 1, 2026. Limestone was ordered to file, by March 2, 2026, updated information regarding the implementation of Phase 1 of the rate increase.

The Commission will hold a public meeting in Counce, Tennessee, on **Thursday, March 26, 2026, from 3:00 p.m. (CDT) to 6:00 p.m. (CDT)** at The Lodge at Pickwick Landing State Park, Magnolia Room A, located at 120 Playground Loop, Counce, TN 38326. Members of the public are invited to attend and present comments. In addition, the Commission will hold a public hearing in this matter in Nashville in Hearing Room G.201, Andrew Jackson State Office Building, 500 Deaderick Street, Nashville, Tennessee,

beginning at 10:00 a.m. (CDT) on April 28, 2026. The public will have another opportunity to comment during the hearing.
