NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

The Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “TPUC”) invites the public to comment on the above-captioned matter regarding Limestone Water Utility Operating Company, LLC’s (“Limestone” or the “Company”) Phase 2 rate increase, which was approved by the Commission on April 14, 2025, as well as any other issues of concern.¹ In its *Order*, the Commission determined that Limestone’s overall revenue deficiency was \$1,362,364 and ordered that the deficiency be recovered in two phases. The first phase began on May 1, 2025, and the second phase is scheduled to begin on May 1, 2026. Limestone was ordered to file, by March 2, 2026, updated information regarding the Phase 1 rate increase to assist with the implementation of the Phase 2 increase.

The Commission will hold a public meeting in Franklin, Tennessee, on **Wednesday, April 8, 2026**, from **4:00 p.m. (CDT) to 7:00 p.m. (CDT)** at the **Williamson County Administrative Complex Auditorium**, 1320 West Main Street, Franklin, TN 37064. Members of the public are invited to attend and present comments.
