Dear Chairman Jones:

The purpose of the filing is to demonstrate Limestone Water Utility Operating Company, LLC's ("Limestone") provision of direct customer notice for the upcoming Hearing on the merits of the above-captioned matter on April 28 and 29, 2026. The undersigned counsel for Limestone hereby furnishes (attached) a representative copy of the direct notice.

In addition to the direct customer notice, a NOTICE OF HEARING was made available at Limestone's business office at 1630 Des Peres Road, Suite 140 Des Peres, MO 63131. As Limestone's customers are in Tennessee, however, Limestone also posted notice on Limestone's Public Notice webpage at <https://centralstateswaterresources.com/limestone-water-regulatory-information/> on or about March 12, 2026.

The notice referenced that on March 2, 2026, Limestone Water Utility Operating Company filed a Phase 2 compliance with the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (TPUC) to implement the second phase of the rate adjustment previously approved in TPUC [Docket No 24-00044](#) and provided a link to the docket. In its July 10, 2025, *Order Setting Utility Rates*, the TPUC approved a phased approach to mitigate bill impacts, with Phase 1 rates implemented effective May 1, 2025, using the Commission-adopted framework. The Commission also directed Limestone Water to make a Phase 2 compliance filing before implementing the second phase, including revenues collected by month and system, updated billing determinants, a proposed rate design to complete the phased-in recovery, and supporting testimony, which are also filed in the docket.

The Company's webpage also contained links to the TPUC Case Docket No. 24-00044 webpage for a complete copy of the petition and related filings, including the Commission's July 10, 2025, *Order Setting Utility Rates*, as well a summary of the current rates pursuant to

Notice is hereby given that, on March 2, 2026, Limestone Water Utility Operating Company, LLC (“Limestone Water”) filed a Phase 2 compliance filing with the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“TPUC” or “Commission”) to implement the second phase of the rate adjustment previously approved in TPUC Docket No. 24-00044. The Phase 2 filing and related materials are available in the Commission’s docket at <http://share.tn.gov/tra/dockets/2400044.htm>. In its July 10, 2025, Order Setting Utility Rates, the Commission approved a phased approach to mitigate bill impacts, with Phase One rates implemented effective May 1, 2025, using the Commission-adopted framework. The Commission also directed Limestone Water to make a Phase 2 compliance filing before implementing the second phase, including revenues collected by month and system, updated billing determinants, a proposed rate design to complete the phased-in recovery, and supporting testimony, which are also filed in the docket.

The Tennessee Public Utility Commission has scheduled public comment hearings regarding Phase 2 of the Rate Increase Implementation (Docket No. 24-00044). These hearings provide customers with an opportunity to offer comments directly to the Commission.


