## **NOTICE ACCEPTING PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION** **WITH FURTHER PROCEEDINGS TO BE DETERMINED**

**IN RE:** *Petition of GO MD USA LLC for Designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier in the State of Tennessee for the Limited Purpose of Providing Lifeline Service to Qualifying Customers*

On April 15, 2025, GO MD USA, LLC ("Company"), filed a *Motion to Reconsider* asking the Commission to reconsider its decision denying the Company designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier ("ETC") to receive federal low-cost funding to provide Lifeline service to qualifying Tennessee consumers.<sup>1</sup> With its *Motion to Reconsider*, the Company filed the Declaration of Mark J. Schirmer, its General Counsel, along with certain documents that had previously been entered into the record.

Please take notice that the Commission accepts the *Motion to Reconsider* only insofar as to prevent the Company's request for reconsideration from being deemed denied by operation of law.<sup>2</sup> The Commission will consider the *Motion to Reconsider* at a later date to be determined. A separate notice will be issued concerning setting further proceedings.
