This matter is before the Administrative Judge of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “TPUC”) upon the *Request to Withdraw Complaint and Petition to Convene a Show Cause Proceeding* (“*Request to Withdraw*”) filed by the Tennessee Public Utility Commission Staff as a Party (“Party Staff”) on February 27, 2025. In its *Request to Withdraw*, Party Staff states that after filing its *Complaint and Petition to Convene a Show Cause Proceeding* (“*Petition*”), GoDaddy.com, LLC (“GoDaddy”) contacted Party Staff regarding its small and minority-owned telecommunications business participation plan (“SMBP”). According to Party Staff, GoDaddy submitted a new, updated SMBP that complies with the annual filing requirement. Based upon GoDaddy’s compliance with the SMBP filing requirement, Party Staff seeks to withdraw its *Petition*. The Administrative Judge finds that Party Staff’s *Request to Withdraw* is well-taken and should be granted.

The *Request to Withdraw Complaint and Petition to Convene a Show Cause Proceeding* filed by Tennessee Public Utility Commission Staff as a Party is granted and the docket is closed.
