ORDER GRANTING REQUEST TO WITHDRAW COMPLAINT AND PETITION TO CONVENE A SHOW CAUSE PROCEEDING

This matter is before the Administrative Judge of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission ("Commission" or "TPUC") upon the Request to Withdraw Complaint and Petition to Convene a Show Cause Proceeding ("Request to Withdraw") filed by the Tennessee Public Utility Commission Staff as a Party ("Party Staff") on February 27, 2025. In its Request to Withdraw, Party Staff states that after filing its Complaint and Petition to Convene a Show Cause Proceeding ("Petition"), GoDaddy.com, LLC ("GoDaddy") contacted Party Staff regarding its small and minority-owned telecommunications business participation plan ("SMBP"). According to Party Staff, GoDaddy submitted a new, updated SMBP that complies with the annual filing requirement. Based upon GoDaddy's compliance with the SMBP filing requirement, Party Staff seeks to withdraw its Petition. The Administrative Judge finds that Party Staff's Request to Withdraw is well-taken and should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

The Request to Withdraw Complaint and Petition to Convene a Show Cause Proceeding filed by Tennessee Public Utility Commission Staff as a Party is granted and the docket is closed.
