ORDER GRANTING REQUEST TO WITHDRAW COMPLAINT AND PETITION TO CONVENE A SHOW
CAUSE PROCEEDING

This matter is before the Administrative Judge of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “TPUC”) upon the *Request to Withdraw Complaint and Petition to Convene a Show Cause Proceeding* (“*Request to Withdraw*”) filed by Tennessee Public Utility Commission Staff as a party (“Party Staff”) on September 26, 2024. In its *Request to Withdraw*, Party Staff states that after filing its *Complaint and Petition to Convene a Show Cause Proceeding* (“*Petition*”), GC Pivotal, LLC (“GC Pivotal”) contacted Party Staff regarding its small and minority-owned telecommunications business plan (“SMBP”). According to Party Staff, GC Pivotal submitted a letter indicating there were no material changes to its SMBP. This letter complied with the annual filing requirement. Based on GC Pivotal’s compliance with the SMBP filing requirement, Party Staff seeks to withdraw its *Petition*. The Administrative Judge finds that Party Staff’s *Request to Withdraw* is well-taken and should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

The *Request to Withdraw Complaint and Petition to Convene a Show Cause Proceeding* filed by Tennessee Public Utility Commission Staff as a party, is granted, and the docket is closed.
