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ORDER GRANTING REQUEST TO WITHDRAW COMPLAINT AND PETITION TO CONVENE A SHOW  
CAUSE PROCEEDING

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This matter is before the Administrative Judge of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “TPUC”) upon the *Request to Withdraw Complaint and Petition to Convene a Show Cause Proceeding* (“*Request to Withdraw*”) filed by Tennessee Public Utility Commission Staff as a party (“Party Staff”) on October 15, 2024. In its *Request to Withdraw*, Party Staff states that after filing its *Complaint and Petition to Convene a Show Cause Proceeding* (“*Petition*”), Crown Castle Fiber, LLC (“CCF”) contacted Party Staff regarding its small and minority-owned telecommunications business plan (“SMBP”). According to Party Staff, CCF submitted an updated SMBP that complied with the annual filing requirement. Based on CCF’s compliance with the SMBP filing requirement, Party Staff seeks to withdraw its *Petition*. The Administrative Judge finds that Party Staff’s *Request to Withdraw* is well-taken and should be granted.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

The *Request to Withdraw Complaint and Petition to Convene a Show Cause Proceeding* filed by Tennessee Public Utility Commission Staff as a party, is granted, and the docket is closed.
