Re: *Docket No. 25-00002 – Petition of Tennessee-American Water Company Regarding the 2024 Production Costs and Other Pass-Throughs Rider (“PCOP”).*

Dear Mr. Lane:

To assist the Commission in its continuing evaluation of this matter, please respond to the following request for information:

- 1.) Confirm that the PCOP Rider surcharge was reset to zero in the same billing cycle as the new base rates authorized by Docket 24-00032 became effective. If so, confirm that customers are not currently being billed a PCOP surcharge amount on their monthly bills. If not, state the current PCOP Rider surcharge being billed to customers. Please explain.
- 2.) Confirm that the Order Setting Rates issued in Docket 24-00032 established a new baseline for PCOP expenses, and that the prospective PCOP Rider surcharge will be filed to collect any over-recovery or under-recovery of baseline PCOP expenses for the period January 1, 2026, through December 31, 2026. Please explain.
- 3.) How do you propose to recover any authorized under-recovery of PCOP expenses through the period ended November 30, 2024? Please explain.
- 4.) File a proposed tariff in this docket to true-up the PCOP expenses through November 30, 2024.

Responses are requested to be provided no later than Tuesday, May 6, 2025. In accordance with the Commission’s rules, please submit your response electronically to the Docket Manager at
