Re: *Petition of Kingsport Power Company D/B/A AEP Appalachian Power for January 2024 through December 2024 Annual Recovery Under the Targeted Reliability Plan and Major Storm Rider ("TRP&MS"), Alternative Rate Mechanisms Approved in Docket No. 17-00032*

Dear Mr. Harvey:

To aid the Commission in its ongoing assessment of this matter, please respond to the following request for information:

- 1.) Refer to Excel file "KgPCo Exhibit No. 1 (MLD)," cell E28. Provide the underlying project cost details for December 2024 to support the Cumulative Capital Addition of \$19,093,392 in the same Excel format that was provided for the previous months.
- 2.) Refer to Excel file "KgPCo Exhibit No. 1 (MLD)," cells I18-I27. In addition, refer to Excel file "WP - YTD KgPCo ADIT Calculation", cells L64-L73.
 - a. Explain why the ADIT amounts from February 2024 to November 2024 do not match within the two files.
 - b. If the monthly amounts are supposed to differ, provide an explanation of why and a calculation to support the amounts used in Excel file "KgPCo Exhibit No. 1 (MLD)," cells I18-I27.
 - c. If the monthly amounts are intended to match, specify which file is correct and provide a replacement file for the one with incorrect monthly amounts.
- 3.) Refer to Excel file "KgPCo Exhibit No. 1 (MLD)," cells O17, O19, O27, and O28. Provide a detailed explanation and appropriate documentation to support the hardcoded adjustment entries within these cells.
- 4.) In its Petition, the Company states that its proposal, if approved, would result in an average monthly increase of \$1.55 to residential customers. However, in witness testimonies, an

increase of \$2.99 is cited, which is also supported by the Company's workpapers. Please clarify this discrepancy.

A response is requested no later than Friday, June 13th.
