The agency received a letter on April 1, 2025, that was assigned to TPUC Docket 25-00024. The letter describes a transaction that results in the indirect transfer of control of Network Innovations, LLC ("Network Innovations").

Network Innovations elected market regulation in a letter filed December 10, 2021, assigned to TPUC Docket Number 21-00145. T.C.A. § 65-5-109(n) provides a description of the regulatory requirements that apply to companies that elect Market Regulation. The transfer of control, as described, is governed by T.C.A. 65-4-113, which is not a regulatory requirement that applies to companies that have elected Market Regulation. As such, the transaction described in the correspondence dated April 1, 2025, does not require approval. As no action is required by the agency, please close the above-referenced docket.
