ORDER APPROVING AMENDMENT TO INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT

This Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement (the “Amendment”), negotiated between Citizens Telecommunications Company of Tennessee, LLC d/b/a Frontier Communications of Tennessee and Peerless Network of Tennessee, LLC pursuant to 47 U.S.C. §251 and §252, was filed with the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the “Commission”) on April 11, 2025.¹ The Amendment has been reviewed, and no portion discriminates against a telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the agreement.

A Notice was filed by the Commission on May 27, 2025, informing the public that the Amendment would be deemed approved by the Commission within ten days of the filing of the Notice unless an objection to the Amendment was filed with the Commission. No objection to the Amendment was received by the Commission. Pursuant to the Notice and absent any objection having been filed with the Commission, the Amendment is approved effective as of June 6, 2025.
