Monica,

The Consumer Advocate would like to request a status conference to address two concerns/issues.

1. Filings by Dart Kendall. Attached is a data request we just received from Mr. Kendall. Besides not following the procedural schedule, this is the second recent document that Mr. Kendall has filed and not his attorney. The response to the Consumer Advocate's data requests were filed by Mr. Kendall also (<https://tpucdockets.tn.gov/archive/filings/2025/2500029m.pdf>). Mr. Kendall was informed at the beginning of this Docket that he would need to be represented by counsel, but it appears that Mr. Kendall continues to represent himself.
2. Request for Public Staff Assignment. Based upon the assistance of Party Staff in TPUC Docket 25-00023, the Consumer Advocate believes this Docket could greatly benefit from the inclusion of Party Staff. Mr. Kendall has stated that he does not regularly use the escrow account except for real emergencies. However, it might benefit both parties to hear from Public Staff on what type of repairs/maintenance were included in O&M in base rates and what repairs/maintenance were expected to from escrow. For example, in Docket No. 25-00023, Party Staff explained that charges for line breaks, panel failures, panel upgrades, plant upgrades, vault replacements, and pump replacements should be funded from escrow accounts. Party Staff could also explain the expectation or process for emergency repairs/maintenance during holidays and weekends.
