To assist the Commission in its ongoing investigation into the above referenced docket, it is requested that responses be provided to the following:

1. Regarding Commission Rule 1220-04-13-.17(2)(d)(1): Provide a letter from TDEC indicating receipt of a complete SOP application for this project. In addition, if a draft permit has been issued, provide a copy.
2. Regarding Commission Rule 1220-04-13-.17(2)(a)(7)(v): Provide preliminary plats/maps of the proposed Firefly development that show (or best estimate of) where the phases of the development will be located relative to the treatment plant.
3. What is Aqua Green's plan to ensure adequate financing will be available to cover the future infrastructure additions to its wastewater system, that are necessary to complete phases two,

three, and four of the Firefly development? Will the performance bond provided in this Petition cover phases two, three, and four of this project? If not, please explain.
