Please allow this letter to serve as our Notification of the Transfer of Control of Megawatt Communications, LLC ("Megawatt") and RSTN Communications, LLC ("RSTN"),

Megawatt is a Tennessee limited liability company licensed as an eligible telecommunications carrier under market regulation in Docket No. 15-00087. RSTN is Delaware holding company formed for the purposes of this proposed transaction.

Pursuant to the terms of the proposed transaction, Megawatt will sell all membership interests to RSTN. Megawatt will continue to operate and expand its networks under the new ownership. The proposed transaction will enhance Megawatt's financial and technical abilities and to provide services pursuant to their RDOF obligations which is consistent with the public interest.

## DOMESTIC 214 APPLICATION GRANTED FOR THE TRANSFER OF CONTROL OF MEGAWATT COMMUNICATIONS LLC TO RSTN COMMUNICATIONS LLC

## WC Docket No. 25-146

By this Public Notice, the Wireline Competition Bureau (Bureau) grants an application filed by Jack Cathey, Megawatt Communications LLC (Megawatt), and RSTN Communications LLC (RSTN) (collectively, Applicants), pursuant to section 214(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and section 63.04 of the Commission's rules, 1 requesting Commission approval for the transfer of control of Megawatt from Jack Cathey to RSTN.2

On April 18, 2025, the Bureau released a public notice seeking comment on the Application.<sup>3</sup> We did not receive comments or petitions in opposition to the Application.

Megawatt, a Tennessee limited liability company, provides communications services in Tennessee.<sup>4</sup> Megawatt is designated as an eligible telecommunications carrier in Tennessee and the Commission authorized Megawatt to receive \$3,847,055.40 in Rural Digital Opportunity Fund (RDOF) support in exchange for its commitment to serve 1,640 locations in Study Area Code (SAC) 299044.<sup>5</sup> Megawatt is currently owned by Jack Cathey, a U.S. citizen who, following the consummation of the proposed transaction, will continue as Megawatt's Chief Operating Officer.<sup>6</sup>

RSTN, a Delaware holding company formed for the purposes of this proposed transaction, is owned by the 2015 Alward Children's Trust (Alward Trust) (66% equity and voting)<sup>7</sup> and Nicholas

Felmlee (34% equity and voting).8

Pursuant to the terms of the proposed transaction, Jack Cathey will sell all membership interests in Megawatt to RSTN.<sup>9</sup> Applicants state Megawatt will continue to operate and expand its networks under the new ownership while also having access to augmented financial, managerial, and technical resources.<sup>10</sup> Applicants assert that the proposed transaction will put Megawatt in a better position to meet its RDOF obligations, including meeting Megawatt's required RDOF milestones.<sup>11</sup> Accordingly, Applicants affirm that the proposed transaction is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity.<sup>12</sup>

## Grant of Application

We find, upon consideration of the record, that the proposed transfer will serve the public interest, convenience, and necessity.<sup>13</sup>

Therefore, pursuant to section 214 of the Act, 47 U.S.C. § 214, and sections 0.91, 0.291, 63.04 of the Commission's rules, 47 CFR §§ 0.91, 0.291, and 63.04, the Bureau hereby grants the Application discussed in this Public Notice, subject to Applicants' compliance with all applicable obligations.

Pursuant to section 1.103 of the Commission's rules, 47 CFR § 1.103, the grant is effective upon release of this Public Notice. Petitions for reconsideration under section 1.106 or applications for review under section 1.115 of the Commission's rules, 47 CFR §§ 1.106, 1.115, may be filed within 30 days of the date of this Public Notice.
