ORDER APPROVING REQUEST TO WITHDRAW PETITION

This matter is before the Administrative Judge of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “TPUC”) upon the letter filed by Mr. Harold Wilson on July 11, 2025, (“Request to Withdraw”), seeking to withdraw the Petition filed on June 23, 2025, requesting a determination whether a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (“CCN”) is necessary for the Tellico Village Property Owners Association (“TVPOA”). In his Request to Withdraw, Mr. Wilson states “[b]ecause the determination that I have requested will be decided by the Commission as a result of the Consumer Advocate’s Complaint, I request to withdraw my determination request.”

The Administrative Judge finds that Mr. Wilson’s Request to Withdraw is well-taken and should be approved. This decision does not impact the viability of the Petition filed by the Consumer Advocate Division of the Office of the Tennessee Attorney General, and it will proceed toward consideration by the Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

The Request to Withdraw filed by Mr. Harold Wison is granted.
