I am curious as to the extremely high water bills in Tellico Village. Five hundred to one thousand dollar bills per month are not uncommon. It seems that Tellico is adding onto our water bills the entire cost of the Tellico Public Works Department to supplement their budget. I think that the water and sewer bills should be invoiced apart from the administrative and operational expenses of Public works. Public works should be billing us separately from water/sewer.
