**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO WITHDRAW APPLICATION FOR AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE COMPETING LOCAL EXCHANGE AND INTEREXCHANGE SERVICE**

This matter is before the Administrative Judge of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the “Commission” or “TPUC”) upon consideration of the *Motion to Withdraw Application for Authority to Provide Competing Local Exchange and Interexchange Service* (“*Motion*”) filed by Uniti Fiber GulfCo, LLC (“GulfCo” or “Applicant”) on October 14, 2025. GulfCo requests to withdraw the *Application of Uniti Fiber GulfCo for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to Provide Competing Local Exchange and Interexchange Telecommunications Services* (“*Application*”) filed by GulfCo on June 30, 2025.


In support of its *Motion*, GulfCo asserts that the Applicant no longer intends to provide telecommunications services within the State and that withdrawal of the application will not prejudice any party or Commission process, as there has been no hearing on the *Application* and no order has been issued by the Commission on the *Application*.¹ No party sought to intervene in this matter. The Commission has received no public comment concerning GulfCo’s application. Therefore, the Administrative Judge finds that GulfCo’s *Motion* is well taken and

should be granted.
