PETITION TO CONVENE A SHOW CAUSE PROCEEDING

Comes now the Tennessee Public Utility Commission ("TPUC" or "Commission") Staff as a party ("Party Staff" or "Petitioner") in accordance with Tenn. Code Ann. §§ 65-2-106, 65-4-120 and Commission Rule 1220-04-08-.09 and requests that the Administrative Judge delegated authority by the Commission issue an Order requiring S&B Tennessee Enterprises Inc. ("S&B TN" or "Company"), formerly known as Monster Broadband Inc. to appear before the Commission to show cause why the Commission should not cancel the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") for noncompliance with statutory requirements.

JURISDICTION

The Commission has a duty to ensure that "all laws of this state over which they have jurisdiction are enforced and obeyed, that violations thereof are promptly prosecuted, and all penalties due the state are collected." Further, the Commission is specifically authorized to issue an order requiring a respondent to appear and show cause why the Commission should not take action as may be indicated in the show cause order. In addition, upon finding that a public utility has violated or failed to comply with regulatory requirements, the Commission is authorized to impose a civil penalty of up to "fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each day of any such violation or failure

...." Commission Rule 1220-04-08-.09(3) states that a telecommunications services provider that violates state law or Commission rule may be subject to civil penalties or the revocation of the provider's CCN.⁴ The Rule establishes a procedure that requires notice to the provider of alleged violations, an opportunity for the provider to respond within 30 days, and the issuance of a Show Cause Order if such response is unsatisfactory.⁵

Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-301(a) requires public utilities to pay an annual fee for the inspection, control and supervision of its business, service, and rates on or before April 1, each year. In accordance with Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-303, the annual inspection fee is based upon the intrastate revenues for the previous year. Further, the section establishes the minimum inspection fee for telecommunications service companies at \$100.6 Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-308 provides for a penalty of 10% per month, or fraction thereof, for inspection fees not received by April 1.

RELEVANT FACTS

- 1. S&B TN is a corporation established in the state of Tennessee. The Company's principal office and mailing address are located at 927 Galloway Ln., Winchester, TN 37398-9009.⁷
- 2. S&B TN was issued a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide competing local telecommunications services throughout the state of Tennessee in this Docket.⁸

- 3. PB Tennessee Asset Entity, LLC ("PB Tennessee") is the holder of a CCN to provide competing local telecommunications services throughout the state of Tennessee in Docket No. 19-00054.9
- 4. John LaBar, Esq., counsel for S&B TN, represented to Party Staff that PB Tennessee, then doing business as Point Broadband Fiber, acquired the telecommunications assets and customers of S&B TN. ¹⁰ S&B TN believed that the transaction included the transfer of the Company's CCN to PB Tennessee. In addition, S&B TN does not provide, and does not intend to provide telecommunications services within the state of Tennessee.
- 5. Conversely, Counsel for PB Tennessee represented to Party Staff that it already has a CCN and did not acquire, and did not intend to acquire, S&B TN's CCN.
- 6. Party Staff previously requested S&B TN to file a request to relinquish its CCN. However, S&B TN has not filed a request to relinquish its CCN.
- 7. S&B TN last paid its annual inspection fee in July 2023. The Company failed to submit the annual inspection fee required from public utilities operating within the state that was due on April 1, 2024 and April 1, 2025.
- 8. Commission Staff sent a reminder letters concerning payment of the annual inspection fee to S&B TN on May 9, 2024, June 11, 2024, July 17, 2024, and April 10, 2025. The July 17, 2024 letter was sent certified, return receipt requested. The return receipt was signed by "T Moore" on July 22, 2024. A copy of the Commission Staff letters and the return receipt are attached as Exhibit 3.

9. As of the date of this filing, S&B TN has neither responded to the Commission

Staff's letters nor submitted the delinquent annual inspection fees.

ALLEGED VIOLATIONS OF STATE LAW

10. The facts alleged in paragraphs 1 through 9 constitute a violation of Tenn. Code

Ann. § 65-4-301, which states, in relevant part:

Every public utility doing business in this state and subject to the

control and jurisdiction of the commission to which this chapter applies, shall pay to the state on or before April 1 of each year, a fee

for the inspection, control and supervision of the business, service

and rates of such public utility.

11. The Commission has provided formal notice of alleged violation of Tenn. Code

Ann. § 65-4-301 to the Company in accordance with Commission Rule 1220-04-08-.09 by the

letters sent on May 9, 2024, June 11, 2024, July 17, 2024, and April 10, 2025. More than 30 days

have passed since these letters were sent to S&B TN with no response.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

Wherefore, Petitioner respectfully requests the Commission open a docket to consider this

Petition to Convene a Show Cause Proceeding and issue an Order requiring S&B TN to appear

before the Commission to show cause why it should not be found in violation of state law and why

the Commission should not cancel the CCN issued to S&B TN.
