Dear Chairman:

Enclosed for filing in the referenced docket is the original Petition for Approval of the Amendment to the Mutual Traffic Exchange Agreement Negotiated by TDS Telecom and CLEC.

In accordance with Section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, the Tennessee Public Utility Commission is charged with approving or rejecting the negotiated Amendment between TDS Telecom and CLEC within 90 days of its submission. The Act provides that the Tennessee Public Utility Commission may only reject such an amendment if it finds that the amendment or any portion of the amendment discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the amendment or the implementation of the amendment or any portion of the amendment is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity.

CLEC and TDS Telecom aver that the Amendment is consistent with the standards for approval. This Amendment adds interconnected VoIP traffic to Section I "Scope of Agreement", and adds Section II A "Indirect Interconnection". TDS Telecom respectfully requests that the Commission approve the Amendment to the Agreement.

First Amendment to Mutual Traffic Exchange Agreement

The Mutual Traffic Exchange Agreement dated March 1, 2007 between TDS Telecommunications LLC (“TDS Telecom”) and Level 3 Communications, LLC (“CLEC”) in Tennessee is hereby amended as follows:

<u>Mutual Traffic Exchange Agreement</u>	<u>Effective</u>
Section I – Scope of Agreement	May 1, 2025
Section II – Connection Arrangements	May 1, 2025

To Section I “**Scope of Agreement**” the following language is added:

Local Traffic may include Interconnected VoIP traffic, as defined by the FCC, that originates and terminates in the same local calling area.

Pursuant to additional Section II A, Exhibit A-1 is added to reflect the mutually agreed upon Points of Interconnection (POIs).

The following section II A is added to “Indirect Interconnection”:

**Section II A
Indirect Interconnection**

The Parties agree that for so long as traffic volumes do not warrant direct interconnection, traffic shall be exchanged by transiting such traffic through third party LEC tandems. Each Party shall be financially and operationally responsible for the entire costs of providing facilities from its network to the POI for the exchange of such traffic.

Where the traffic exchanged between CLEC and a specific TDS Telecom host or end office switch requires twenty-four (24) or more trunks for three consecutive months, or it is otherwise economically advantageous, the Parties shall implement direct trunks to the specific host or end office switch in accordance with Section II Connection Arrangements. The Parties agree to negotiate in good faith to reach agreement to accommodate direct interconnection.

The remaining terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in effect.
