**RE: *Distribution of Litigation Proceeds made pursuant to the PLUS Tariff,
TPUC Docket No. 25-00086***

Dear Chairman Hilliard:

On February 17, 2026, the Tennessee Public Utility Commission approved Tennessee-American Water Company's ("TAWC") request to establish a PFAS (Per-and Poly-Fluoroalkyl Substances) Litigation Universal Surcredit Tariff ("PLUS Tariff").

Terms of the approved tariff state that TAWC shall provide written notice within seven (7) days to the Commission of any distribution made pursuant to the tariff, including the amount of such proceeds included and supporting workpapers showing the determination of the credit.

This letter serves as TAWC's written notice to the Commission of a distribution made pursuant to the tariff.

On Friday, August 31, 2026, proceeds from the PFAS litigation MDL were credited to customer bills. These proceeds were received by TAWC from 3M, DuPont, Tyco, and BASF. A total of **\$1,071,065** in PFAS litigation proceeds was included in this distribution, resulting in a bill credit of **\$11.92** to each of TAWC's 89,830 eligible customer accounts.

The attached exhibit shows the amount of such proceeds included and provides the required detail showing the determination of the credit as outlined in the tariff. Also attached is an affidavit verifying that any credits made pursuant to this tariff are consistent with the terms of the PLUS Tariff. A copy of this notice is also provided to the Consumer Advocate Division, Office of the Tennessee Attorney General.

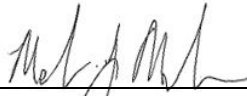
