This letter notifies the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) that TEC of Jackson, Inc. (“TEC of Jackson”), which is authorized to provide Competitive Local Exchange, Exchange Access, and Resold Interexchange Telecommunications services in the State of Tennessee,¹ elects to operate pursuant to market regulation, in accordance with the Market Regulation Act of 2009 and Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-5-109.

¹ A Certificate of Convenience and Necessity was originally issued to CommuniGroup of Jackson, Inc. (“CGJ”) in Docket No. 95-02751, authorizing it to provide Resold Interexchange services in Tennessee. Subsequently, CGJ was granted authorization to provide Competitive Local Exchange and Exchange Access services in Tennessee in Docket No. 03-00172. Later, CGJ changed its name to TEC of Jackson, which the Commission approved on April 17, 2009 in Docket No. 09-00031.
