ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE CUSTOMER OWNED COIN OR COINLESS OPERATED TELEPHONE SERVICE

This matter came before Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard, Director Kenneth C. Hill and Director Robin Morrison of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority" or "TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on June 20, 2016. Knoxville Payphone & Vending (the "Company") filed an Application to provide Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone ("COCOT") service within the State of Tennessee in 1990. On June 27, 1990, the Tennessee Public Service Commission issued an order stating that the Company had met all the requirements to provide COCOT service in Tennessee. On May 17, 2016, the TRA received a request from the Company to cancel its authority, stating that it no longer provides pay telephone service in Tennessee. Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.
