**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE
CUSTOMER OWNED COIN OR COINLESS OPERATED TELEPHONE SERVICE**

This matter came before Chairman Eddie Roberson, Director Sara Kyle and Director Mary W. Freeman of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on July 11, 2011. P&D Telecommunications, Inc. (the "Company") originally filed an Application to provide Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone ("COCOT") service within the State of Tennessee on June 28, 1990. On June 29, 1990, the Tennessee Public Service Commission ("TPSC") issued an order stating that the Company had met all the requirements to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.¹ On June 29, 2011, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its authority. Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to cancel, by request, the authority of P&D Telecommunications, Inc. to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.
