

**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE
CUSTOMER OWNED COIN OR COINLESS OPERATED TELEPHONE SERVICE**

This matter came before Chairman Eddie Roberson, Director Kenneth C. Hill, and Director Mary W. Freeman of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on August 22, 2011. Arthur Moreland originally filed an Application to provide Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone ("COCOT") service within the State of Tennessee in 1990. This Application was subsequently approved by the Tennessee Public Service Commission. A name change to Community Market was approved by the TRA on March 12, 2007 in Docket No. 07-00016. On July 28, 2011, Community Market requested that the TRA cancel its authority. Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to cancel, by request, the authority of Community Market to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.
