**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE  
CUSTOMER OWNED COIN OR COINLESS OPERATED TELEPHONE SERVICE**



This matter came before Chairman Sara Kyle, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Ron Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on July 24, 2006. Oak Valley Lanes (the "Company") originally filed an Application to provide Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone ("COCOT") service within the State of Tennessee on July 24, 1990. On July 25, 1990, the Tennessee Public Service Commission issued an order stating that the Company had met all the requirements to operate COCOT service in Tennessee. On June 28, 2006, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its authority to provide COCOT service in Tennessee. Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to cancel, by request, the authority of Oak Valley Lanes to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.
