


**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE
CUSTOMER OWNED COIN OR COINLESS OPERATED TELEPHONE SERVICE**

This matter came before the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA") at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on May 7, 2012. Coletta's Italian Restaurant (the "Company") originally filed an Application to provide Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone ("COCOT") service within the State of Tennessee on September 7, 1990. The Application was subsequently approved by the Tennessee Public Service Commission. On April 17, 2012, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its authority. Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to cancel, by request, the authority of Coletta's Italian Restaurant to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.
