ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE CUSTOMER OWNED COIN OR COINLESS OPERATED TELEPHONE SERVICE

This matter came before Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard, Vice Chairman David F. Jones, Commissioner Kenneth C. Hill, Commissioner David Crowell, and Commissioner John Hie of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the "Commission"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, during a regularly scheduled Commission Conference held on June 17, 2024. Springwater, Inc. ("Company") was granted authority to provide Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone ("COCOT") services in Tennessee by final order issued in this docket on February 25, 2013. In a letter filed on December 8, 2023, the Company requested that the authority granted to it in this docket be cancelled effective immediately. Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the Commissioners voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.
