**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE
CUSTOMER OWNED COIN OR COINLESS OPERATED TELEPHONE SERVICE**

This matter came before Chairman Kenneth C. Hill, Director Herbert H. Hilliard and Director James M. Allison of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority" or "TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on September 10, 2012. ProComm, Inc. (the "Company") originally filed an Application to provide Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone ("COCOT") service within the State of Tennessee on December 17, 1990. On April 16, 1991, the Tennessee Public Service Commission issued an order stating that the Company had met all the requirements to provide COCOT service in Tennessee. On August 27, 2012, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its authority. Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to cancel, by request, the authority of ProComm, Inc. to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.
