
WHEREFORE, having considered the matter the Public Service Commission finds that the above captioned docket should be dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


1. That the request of Air Products and Chemicals, Inc. for an interruptible tariff from Kingsport Power Company be, and the same is hereby dismissed without prejudice.

2. That any party aggrieved by the Commission's decision in this matter may file a Petition for Reconsideration with the Tennessee Public Service Commission within ten (10) days from and after the date of this Order.


