

**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE
CUSTOMER OWNED COIN OR COINLESS OPERATED TELEPHONE SERVICE**

This matter came before Director Tre Hargett, Director Sara Kyle and Director Ron Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on May 5, 2008. Grace Baptist Church of Hamilton County (the "Company") originally filed an Application to provide Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone ("COCOT") service within the State of Tennessee on February 19, 1992. On March 24, 1992, the Tennessee Public Service Commission issued an order stating that the Company had met all the requirements to provide COCOT service in Tennessee. On April 24, 2008, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its authority to provide COCOT service in Tennessee. Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.


