**ORDER**




This matter is before the Commission upon the request of LCI International Telecom Corp. (LCI Telecom), successor corporation to Teledial America Inc. or petitioner to withdraw its application. On November 6, 1992, the petitioner filed the above application, but did not pursue a hearing on the matter. In 1995 LCI Inc. through its subsidiary, LCI Telemanagement Corp., filed an application for Authority for Operator Services and/or Resell Interexchange Telecommunications Services pursuant to Commission Rule 1220-4-2-.57. Such authority was granted in Docket No. 95-03181 by Order issued on September 12, 1995. By letter dated May 2, 1996 LCI Telecom asked to withdraw Teledial America's application in this docket. The Commission finds that the petitioner's request should be granted.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

1. The request of the petitioner, LCI Telecom to withdraw the application of Teledial America, Inc. in this docket is granted and this docket is hereby closed; and
2. Any party aggrieved with the Commission's decision in this matter may file a Petition for Reconsideration with the Commission within ten ( 10 ) days from and after the date of this Order; and
3. Any party aggrieved with the Commission's decision in this matter has the right of judicial review by filing a petition with the Tennessee Court of Appeals, Middle Section, within sixty ( 60 ) days from and after the date of this Order.
