To Whom it may concern:

This will provide formal notice, pursuant to Regulation 1220-4-8-.05, that ICG Telecom Group, Inc., a wholly owned subsidiary of ICG Communications, Inc., intends to abandon its certificates of operating authority for all telecommunications services in the state of Tennessee effective as soon as possible, but not later than May 17, 2006. ICG is today also filing a Motion for Waiver of Regulation 1220-4-8.05 requiring 90 days notice of abandonment.

ICG was certificated to provide interexchange and competitive local services in Docket 93-07922. It also has tariffs on file with the Tennessee Regulatory Authority. ICG, however, offers no telecommunications services in the state and has no facilities in the state used for the provision of regulated telecommunications services. It also has no customers of telecommunications services in the state. It desires, therefore, to abandon all operating authority and cancel all tariffs.

BEFORE THE TENNESSEE REGULATORY AUTHORITY

IN THE MATTER OF THE MOTION BY ICG TELECOM GROUP, INC. FOR WAIVER OF NOTICE RULE

MOTION FOR WAIVER OF RULE

Pursuant to section 1220-1-1-.05 of the Rules of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority, ICG Telecom Group, Inc. ("ICG") respectfully requests that the Tennessee Regulatory Authority grant it a waiver of the 90 day notice requirement for abandonment of a certificate of operating authority required by section 1220-4-8-.05 of the Authority's rules. In support of this Application, ICG states the following.

ICG Telecom Group, Inc. is a wholly owned subsidiary of ICG Communications, Inc. Although ICG is certificated in Tennessee to provide both local and long distance services, it does not offer any telecommunications services in the state, has no customers, and has no facilities located in the state used to offer regulated telecommunications services. Therefore, it desires to abandon its certificates of operating authority.

Section 1220-4-8-.05 of the Rules of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority require ninety days notice to customers before a certificate can be abandoned. However, since ICG does not have any customers in the state, nor does it offer any local calling services as contemplated by section 1220-4-8-.05, it respectfully respects waiver of the ninety day requirement prior to the Commission allowing it to abandon its certificates. Further, because ICG is currently in discussions to sell the majority of its assets and operations, it would like to accomplish the abandonment of its certificates within the next 30 days, or no later than May 17, 2006.

WHEREFORE, ICG Telecom Group, Inc. respectfully requests that the Tennessee Operating Authority, pursuant to section 1220-1-1-.5 of the Authority's rules, grant it a waiver of the ninety day notice requirement prior to abandoning its certificates.
