To Whom it may concern:

ICG Telecom Group, Inc. ("ICG") submitted a request to cancel its certificates of operating authority and all tariffs on April 17, 2006. The Tennessee Regulatory Authority subsequently sent a letter to BellSouth to confirm that BellSouth was no longer providing any services to ICG. In response, BellSouth indicated it was still providing some services to ICG. Upon further investigation, ICG has discovered that a previous agreement with BellSouth to transfer ICG's services and customers to Xspedius has not been completely finalized. This Authority approved that transfer in Docket No. 05-00103 on June 15, 2005.

ICG is working diligently with BellSouth to finally complete this transfer. BellSouth has indicated that they are trying to complete the transfer of all remaining services and/or customers to Xspedius by June 15, 2006. ICG will notify the Authority as soon as that transfer is completed, and will request that BellSouth do the same.

Accordingly, ICG requests that its previously filed request to cancel its certificate and all tariffs be placed on a hearing agenda for conclusion as soon as possible after the transfer has been completed, but in no event later than June 26, 2006.
