
**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Chairman Sara Kyle, Director Pat Miller and Director Ron Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on September 11, 2006. ICG Access Services, Inc.¹ (the "Company") originally filed an Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide telecommunications services in Tennessee in 1993. The Tennessee Public Service Commission subsequently found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On April 19, 2006 the Company requested that the TRA cancel its CCN. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its CCN.
