

**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE
CUSTOMER OWNED COIN OR COINLESS OPERATED TELEPHONE SERVICE**

This matter came before Chairman Sara Kyle, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Pat Miller of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on September 11, 2006. Nigel Barker (the "Company") originally filed an Application to provide Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone ("COCOT") service within the State of Tennessee on October 15, 1993. On October 20, 1993, the Tennessee Public Service Commission issued an order stating that the Company had met all the requirements to operate COCOT service in Tennessee. On August 30, 2006, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its authority to provide COCOT service in Tennessee. Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to cancel, by request, the authority of Nigel Barker to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.
