**ORDER REVOKING AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE COCOT SERVICES
IN TENNESSEE FOR NON-PAYMENT OF FEES**

This matter came before Vice Chairman David F. Jones, Director Kenneth C. Hill and Director Robin Morrison of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the “Authority” or “TRA”), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on October 19, 2015 to revoke the authority of Inmate Communications Corporation (the “Company”) to offer Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone (“COCOT”) service in Tennessee due to non-payment of fees.

The Company originally filed an Application to provide COCOT service within the State of Tennessee in 1993. On December 17, 1993, the Tennessee Public Service Commission issued an order stating that the Company had met all the requirements to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.

Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-301(b) (2015), every owner or operator of a public pay telephone shall submit to the TRA an annual inspection and supervision fee for each service location on or before July 1 of each year. A notice advising the Company of its obligation to comply with the requirements of Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-301(b) (2015) was mailed on

October 16, 2014, and a Notice of Cancellation was mailed on April 30, 2015, via certified mail. That notice was returned as undeliverable. As of the October 19, 2015 Authority Conference, the Company had failed to submit its annual inspection and supervision fee to the Authority.


Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to revoke the Company's authority to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

As a result of non-payment of fees, the authority granted to Inmate Communications Corporation to provide COCOT service within the State of Tennessee is revoked, and this docket is closed.
