ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE CUSTOMER OWNED COIN OR COINLESS OPERATED TELEPHONE SERVICE

This matter came before Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard, Vice Chairman David F. Jones and Director Kenneth C. Hill of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority" or "TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on June 20, 2016. American Telephone Exchange (the "Company") filed an Application to provide Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone ("COCOT") service within the State of Tennessee on January 27, 1994. On February 14, 1994, the Tennessee Public Service Commission issued an order stating that the Company had met all the requirements to provide COCOT service in Tennessee. The Company's authority to provide COCOT service was cancelled at an Authority Conference held on September 14, 1999, at the Company's request, and was reinstated at an Authority Conference held on March 26, 2002. On May 17, 2016, the TRA received a request from the Company to cancel its authority. Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.
