**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE
CUSTOMER OWNED COIN OR COINLESS OPERATED TELEPHONE SERVICE**

This matter came before Chairman James M. Allison, Vice Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard and Director Kenneth C. Hill of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority" or "TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on December 17, 2012. Robert S. Edgerton (the "Company") originally filed an Application to provide Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone ("COCOT") service within the State of Tennessee on August 29, 1994. On September 16, 1994, the Tennessee Public Service Commission issued an order stating that the Company had met all the requirements to provide COCOT service in Tennessee. On October 29, 2012, the TRA received a request from the Company to cancel its authority. Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to cancel, by request, the authority of Robert S. Edgerton to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.
