
**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE
CUSTOMER OWNED COIN OR COINLESS OPERATED TELEPHONE SERVICE**

This matter came before Chairman Eddie Roberson, Director Pat Miller and Director Ron Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on August 20, 2007. Platinum Plus (the "Company") originally filed an Application to provide Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone ("COCOT") service within the State of Tennessee on November 16, 1994. On December 9, 1994, the Tennessee Public Service Commission issued an order stating that the Company had met all the requirements to provide COCOT service in Tennessee. On August 9, 2007, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its authority to provide COCOT service in Tennessee. Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to cancel, by request, the authority of Platinum Plus to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.
