Dear Chairman Allison:

Pursuant to TRA Rule 1220-4-8-.05, Gulf Long Distance, Inc. ("Gulf") hereby notifies the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA") of abandonment of its certificate of public convenience. Due to changed business plans, Gulf no longer seeks to remain certificated in Tennessee.

Gulf does not provide telecommunications service and does not market telecommunications services to any customers in Tennessee. Gulf also does not have tariffs on file with the TRA. Finally, Gulf does not purchase any facilities, UNEs, or resold lines from other Tennessee carriers.

Accordingly, Gulf requests that the TRA issue an order cancelling Gulf's certificate of public convenience.
