## ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

This matter came before Chairman James M. Allison, Vice Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard and Director Kenneth C. Hill of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the “Authority” or “TRA”), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on July 15, 2013. Gulf Long Distance, Inc. (“Gulf” or the “Company”) filed an Application for authority to provide operator services and/or resell telecommunications services in Tennessee on May 24, 1995. On August 2, 1995, the Tennessee Public Service Commission issued an order stating that the Company had met all the requirements for certification. On May 24, 2013, the TRA received a request from Gulf to cancel its authority.<sup>1</sup> Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Directors voted unanimously to grant the Company’s request to cancel its authority.
