ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE CUSTOMER OWNED COIN OR COINLESS OPERATED TELEPHONE SERVICE

This matter came before Chairman Eddie Roberson, Director Kenneth C. Hill, and Director Mary W. Freeman of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on August 22, 2011. KeeSee Bonding Co. (the "Company") originally filed an Application to provide Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone ("COCOT") service within the State of Tennessee on July 14, 1995. On September 28, 1995, the Tennessee Public Service Commission issued an order stating that the Company had met all the requirements to provide COCOT service in Tennessee. On July 15, 2011, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its authority. Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to cancel, by request, the authority of KeeSee Bonding Co. to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.
