


**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Chairman Eddie Roberson, Director Pat Miller and Director Ron Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on October 8, 2007. Connect America Communications, Inc. (the "Company") originally filed its Application for authority to provide operator services and/or resell telecommunications services on July 19, 1995. On August 2, 1995, the Tennessee Public Service Commission issued an order stating that the Company had met all the requirements for certification. On September 5, 2007 the Company requested that the TRA cancel its authority. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.
