**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY  
TO PROVIDE RESOLD TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

---

This matter came before Vice Chair Kenneth C. Hill, Commissioner Herbert H. Hilliard, and Commissioner John Hie of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the “Commission” or “TPUC”), the voting panel assigned to this docket, during a regularly scheduled Commission Conference held on December 9, 2019. Operator Service Company, LLC (“OSC” or the “Company”) was granted authority to provide operator services and/or resell telecommunications by the Tennessee Public Utility Commission on September 12, 1995.

On November 19, 2019, the Commission received a request from OSC to cancel its authority to provide telecommunications services in Tennessee. The cancellation request from OSC stated that the Company had closed its business effective February 28, 2019 and currently has no customers in Tennessee or elsewhere. The Company also stated that they are current on all annual reports and payment of inspection fees.


Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Commissioners voted unanimously to grant the Company’s request to cancel its
