ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY  
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

This matter came before Chairman Eddie Roberson, Director Sara Kyle and Director Mary W. Freeman of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on May 18, 2009. Long Distance of Michigan, Inc. d/b/a LDMI Long Distance<sup>1</sup> (the "Company") originally filed an Application for authority to provide operator services and/or resell telecommunications services in Tennessee on September 5, 1995. On March 22, 1996, the Tennessee Public Service Commission issued an order stating that the Company had met all the requirements for certification. On May 5, 2009, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its authority.<sup>2</sup> Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.
