ORDER

This matter is before the Tennessee Public Service Commission upon the joint petition of Citizens Utilities Company, dba Citizens Telecommunications Company of Tennessee ("CUC-Tennessee") and Citizens Telecommunications Company of Tennessee L.L.C. ("CTC-TN") for approval of a transfer of authority as described in the caption above.

The petition has been investigated by the Commission Staff and recommended for approval. In addition, no party has objected or intervened in this matter. This petition transfers the Tennessee assets and authorities, previously acquired from GTE-South, Inc. (GTE), into a Limited Liability Corporation owned by Citizens and its Citizens

Telecommunications Company subsidiary (CTC). This transfer alters only the legal form and not the substance of Citizen's ownership of the former GTE operations.

The Commission considered this matter at its regularly scheduled Commission

Conference held on September 19, 1995. It was concluded after careful consideration of
the petition filed in this docket, the results of the Staff's investigation, and all applicable

statutes, rules and regulations, that the transfer should be approved as requested.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the transfer of the authorities, properties and services of Citizens
 Utilities Company, dba Citizens Telecommunications Company of Tennessee to Citizens
 Telecommunications Company of Tennessee L.L.C. as set out and requested in the
 petition filed with this Commission on September 1, 1995 is hereby approved;
- 2. That all certificates of Convenience and Necessity issued by this

 Commission for local exchange services in the name of Citizens Utilities Company, dba

 Citizens Telecommunications Company of Tennessee be reissued in the name of Citizens

 Telecommunications Company of Tennessee L.L.C., and full authority to provide said

 services in the territories authorized by these certificates is hereby vested in that company;
- 3. That any party aggrieved with the Commission's decision in this matter may file a Petition for Reconsideration with the Commission within ten (10) days from and after the date of this Order;
- 4. That any party aggrieved with the Commission's decision in this matter has the right of judicial review by filing a petition with the Tennessee Court of Appeals,

 Middle Section within sixty (60) days from and after the date of this Order.
