CONSENT ORDER OF DISPOSITION

Upon the agreement of the parties, as evidenced by the signatures of counsel approving this Order, it appears to the Public Service Commission that the interventions of AT&T Communications of the South Central States, Inc. and Time Warner Axs of Tennessee, L.P. should be withdrawn and the tariff filing subject to this proceeding should become effective upon final Commission approval on February 20, 1996. It further appears that the parties acknowledge that the issues raised by the intervenors have not been decided on the merits and that the parties may raise these issues without prejudice, in any other subsequent Commission docket or proceeding.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED:

1. The Petitions of Intervention filed by AT&T Communications of the South Central States, Inc. and Time Warner Axs of Tennessee, L.P. are hereby withdrawn and Tariff No. 95-226 shall become effective immediately upon final approval of the Public Service Commission; and

2. AT&T of the South Central States, Inc. and Time Warner Axs of Tennessee, L.P. shall be permitted to raise the issues presented in their Petitions for Intervention in this proceeding and in any other subsequent proceeding before the Public Service


Commission without prejudice.


